# THE BRONZE SNAKE

**NUMBERS 21:4-9**  
**GOD TOLD HIS PEOPLE TO LOOK AT THE**  
**BRONZE SNAKE TO BE HEALED.**



## WARM UP ACTIVITY

SAY • I am going to announce a scenario. If the situation would make you unhappy, cross your arms and say, “Grumble, grumble, grumble.” If it would make you happy, stand and shout, “Hurray!”

Call out several scenarios. For example: • Your mom makes your favorite dinner. • Your dad asks you to take out the trash. • You have to share your room with your little sister.

SAY • In today's Bible story, the Israelites forgot all the wonderful things God had done for them, and they complained. Do you think God was happy to hear them complain? Listen to today's Bible story to find out what happened.

## FAMILY REVIEW & DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why did God send poisonous snakes to the Israelites? (They sinned by complaining against Him, Num. 21:7)
2. Did the people admit that they had done something wrong? (yes, Num. 21:7)
3. What did the people tell Moses to do? (to ask God to take the snakes away, Num. 21:7)
4. What did God tell Moses to put on a pole? (a bronze snake, Num. 21:8)
5. How were the Israelites saved? (Anyone bitten by a snake would look at the bronze serpent and live, Num. 21:9)
6. What are some things that you complain about?
7. Was God punishing the people just to be unkind to them?
8. When we sin, where should we look? (to Jesus)
9. Is it easy to look to Jesus? Why?
